Perfect images on your desktop

Lightroom editing tools are intuitive and powerful. So making basic adjustments to color and brightness are a snap. Retouching, local adjustments, and perspective corrections are quick and simple.

Lightroom edits are non-destructive, which means you can experiment fearlessly, and then revert to your original with just one click.



To demonstrate proficiency advanced photography students will:

- Import photos from memory cards and cloud drives efficiently.
- Crop & straighten images in Lr
- Master the basic adjustments in the Lr sliders to adjust color cast, brightness, contrast, shadows, highlights, saturation & luminance
- Use the brush tool to make adjustments to select areas of the image
- Export images with appropriate size settings
- Experiment with presets
- Develop personal voice by refining techniques for presentation choosing at least 3 adjustments from the following tools to create personal pre-sets
 - Vignette effect
 - Use the HSL (Hue, Saturation, Luminance) panel to make individualized color adjustments
 - Use the split toning panel to adjust shadows and highlights independently

This is how professional photographers develop a personal style and voice.
